ADMISSION PROCESS

St. Joseph's Hospital School of Nursing offers a 14 month nursing program of study which qualifies the graduate to take the National Council of License Examination (NCLEX) leading to licensure as a Registered Nurse (RN). The course of study is based on our nursing curriculum and twelve college general education courses. The prerequisite courses are listed below. All courses must be completed with a C or better at an accredited college. Science courses must be less than 10 years old.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

Applications for the October class of 2011 will end on September 12, 2011.

50 students will be admitted in October 2011 and April 2012.

This is a full time day program which is 14 months in length.

Tuition is currently \$25,000 and the application fee is \$150.00.

Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 2.6 .

Applicants will be required to take the Kaplan preadmission entrance test. Information about the test go to: Amazon.com
